During 2008, the Major Hospital Foundation... ..

Made a grant in the amount of \$9,600 to the Social Services Department for prescription assistance for in-patients.

Through 2009,

\$6,139 was been spent from the grant on 93 prescriptions, helping 55 patients.

During 2010,... ..

Granted \$10,000 more to the prescription assistance program. During 2010, this grant purchased 179 prescriptions for seventy patients at a cost of \$5,634.

Through 9/30/2011... ..

\$2,760 has been spent for 116 prescriptions for 40 patients.

Prescription Assistance Grant: A grant made by the Major Hospital Foundation to help “bridge” in-patients who lack resources to purchase their prescriptions between the time they’re written and the time that long-term prescription help can be obtained. The Prescription Assistance Program is part of The 2011 Gift of Health Community Initiative.
